

# North Arlington Police Department Information Sheet

## Public Safety Alert Regarding COVID-19

- Borough Hall is closed to the public and only accessible by making an appointment by phone with the department that you need to visit. Phone numbers can be found on our borough website. Admittance will be from the side door adjacent to the parking lot next to the visitor parking spaces. When you enter you will be asked a series of health and travel related questions.
- Police are asking that you refrain from coming into our building during this crisis.
- Police Response from the North Arlington Police Department will continue with a few temporary changes:
  1. Reports will be taken over the phone, fax, and email, for incidents that do not require a police response.
  2. Walk in customers will be asked to phone in their reports for incidents that do not require a police response.
  3. For customers that must respond to our police headquarters, please call the department you will be visiting first so we can have what you need ready and your time in our facility will be expedited.
  4. Officers will still be responding to calls that require a police response utilizing heightened precautions when interacting with the public because of the COVID-19 Virus.
  5. Police, Fire, and Emergency Medical Technicians are requesting that if they respond to your residence on a call for service, you should meet them at the front door to help limit their time inside the residence.
  6. If you call our police desk for assistance our dispatchers have been instructed to ask a series of questions pertaining to a potential for a COVID-19 virus exposure. Officers and our Emergency Medical Technicians have been trained on how to handle responses to individuals experiencing symptoms of the flu and COVID-19.
  7. If you have to come into our police headquarters you will be stopped at the door and asked a series of questions regarding travel and health.
  8. Internal affairs complaints will also be taken over the phone.

- If you are quarantined (mandatory or self-imposed) in your home due to possible confirmed COVID-19 exposure, PLEASE notify 9-1-1 or our dispatcher at 201-991-4400 when you call and advise the dispatcher.
- Be aware of the potential for phone and door-to-door scams by actors posing as representatives from government agencies and other types of scams in attempts to get you to pay money to them.
- Please keep in mind that we need to work together to protect our personnel so that they can continue to serve the emergency needs of our community.
