MATT BOCCHI is a well-known author and speaker who gained recognition for his best-selling memoir, *Sway*—the first story told by a child of 9/11. In the book, he shares his tumultuous journey of overcoming various struggles, including the loss of his father on 9/11, addiction, and trauma. Matt also talks about his experiences with mental health challenges, such as depression and PTSD, and his path toward healing and recovery.

Matt's journey has been featured in numerous documentaries and TV appearances, including *Fox News Digital Originals* and *History's 9/11: The Legacy*. With over nine years of sobriety, Matt now shares his personal story to inspire others to speak up and seek support for their mental health issues, trauma, and addiction. His advocacy work emphasizes the importance of reducing the stigma of addiction and mental health. Matt's purpose is to impact at least one life each time he shares his story and to be "a voice" for those still suffering.
